- 3. When we hear God's voice, we are expected to act in obedience to it. What examples can you think of in the Bible where this was not done? Have you ever acted contrary or not acted at all after hearing God speak? How did it feel?
- 4. If you are happy to, share how you believe God is speaking to you now or in the recent past. What way did he choose to speak to you? Do you feel open to communicating with God, or are you struggling?
- 5. When God has spoken in the past, how do you remember what he has said?
- 6. What advice would you give to a new Christian who wants to hear from God?
