Numbers 11:4-35

### What Not to Do

1. (v4-6) Why is it important to look back and remember the past? Give examples of all the ways God has already worked in and through you, especially his provision when life was hard.
2. (v10-15) Why do we complain? Do you ever find yourself caught up in an attitude of grumbling and complaining? (This might be at work, driving, at home, even in church.) What might help you stop?
3. “When you stop trusting God, the future disappears.” Why? Have you ever experienced this yourself? What is the best way of dealing with doubts and fears?
4. (v32) Ten homers would be equivalent to 2,200 litres. (*Try and imagine what this would look like*). Why did the people gather so much? Can you give examples of this happening today? How does greed affect others? How can we be countercultural?
5. We should thank God for his provision, trust him for the future, and be generous every day. What measures can you put in place to remind yourself and maintain the right attitude? How should we react when faced with people who have forgotten these truths about God?
6. Spend time thanking God for all he has done, trusting him to take care of the future, and asking where you might show generosity and charity every day.
