Responding to God's call

- 1. The Bible is brutally honest about the people within its pages. How does this encourage you? What would you say to someone who uses the mistakes and disobedience recorded in the Bible to disparage God or other Christians? (for instance, Richard Dawkins calls God "a vindictive, bloodthirsty ethnic cleanser.")
- 2. Do you believe you are where God wants you to be at this time? Why/Why not? Give examples of times when God moved you on to a new thing.
- 3. (v1) What does it mean to be humble? How can we develop this in our daily walk with God? (Read Gal 5:22-23)
- 4. (v2-3) What "noises" take up your time and attention? How do we decide which are important? How can we tune out from the constant interruptions and demands, and be attentive to God?
- 5. (v5-6) Why was Moses told to take off his sandals? What would be a modern equivalent?
- 6. (v7-10) How would you feel if you were Moses? Can you think of times when God asked you to do something that you felt was above your abilities, or outside your comfort zone? What happened? Are you willing to be a partner in God's plans?
